Your request for the nature of these requests is declined pursuant to section 6(a) of LGOIMA, that good reason exists to withhold the information as it may be likely to prejudice the maintenance of the law, including the investigation of these complaints. This information is also withheld pursuant to section 7(2)(a) of LGOIMA to protect the privacy of natural persons.

Once the investigations are completed we will review our decision to withhold this information.
