## Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 Request

I refer to your e-mail of 6 March requesting information relating to kerbside collection and recycling. Response to your questions are set out below.

1 The total tonnage of recycling collected from kerbside collection each financial year for the past five years.

Year	Total Tonnes of Recycling Sold (Glass and Comingled) tonnes	Total Contamination tonnes
2013	9,049.13	1,153.47
2014	8,653.58	1,409.69
2015	8,216.81	1,528.07
2016	8,025.16	1,769.88
2017	7,414.97	1,830.10

The total amount of that kerbside collection sent to landfill due to contamination each financial year for the past five years.

Please refer to the table above – 'Total Contamination'.

3 How much does contaminated recycling cost the council each year (broken down into the last five financial years)?

Please see the table below. The cost is calculated as the total contamination tonnage x the landfill gate charge for general solid waste. The gate rate has increased from \$80/tonne in 2013/14 to \$171/tonne in 2017/18.

2017/18	\$312,947.10

- 4 How much has the council spent on recycling generally in the past five financial years?
  - The Council has spent approximately \$12.5 million on recycling in the past 5 years.
- 5 The amount of waste in tonnes that has gone into your landfill (not recycling) in the past five financial years, broken into years.
