**Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA) request for information on parking tickets**

I am writing in response to your LGOIMA request of 15 February 2019 requesting information on parking tickets.

In answer to your questions raised.

- 1) In 2018 there were 1045 infringements issued for parking on a footpath.
- 2) In 2018 91 infringements were issued by the Officer that issued your tickets.
- 3) There are currently 10 Parking Officers and 1 Parking Officer Special Duties.
- 4) Written cautions across all offences during 2018 totalled 165. As these were cautions only, we cannot quantify the number of cautions for parking on a footpath only. We do not hold information on the number of verbal or friendly warnings. A copy of the friendly warning pamphlet is attached which is left on the offending vehicle.
- 5) The Officers have no set quotas.

I hope this is of assistance.

## A Friendly Warning

This is not a ticket but... when you park remember you may receive one if you park:

- ☐ On the footpath
- ☐ On a bus stop
- ☐ Within 6m of an intersection
- ☐ Facing on-coming traffic
- ☐ On a clearway
- ☐ Within 1m of a vehicle entrance
- ☐ On a residents' parking area
- ☐ Contrary to any road marking or sign
- ☐ On a grass verge
- ☐ In a Pay and Display area for more than 5 minutes without evidence of payment displayed
- ☐ In a Pay and Display area for longer than the maximum stay
- ☐ Failing to display a valid licence label or a current WOF
- ☐ On a road while exempt from continuous licensing
- ☐ Other:
