I am writing in response to your request made on 3 September 2019, please find below the responses to your questions raised.

- Q What is meant by a nuisance complaint and by whom?
- A Section 29 of the Health Act 1956 defines nuisances. Any complaint describing pest control would be considered to be a nuisance complaint.
- Q How was feline status of feral ascertained?
- An assessment is made on the appearance and behaviour of a cat that is trapped. If there is any possibility that the cat is domesticated, it is released.
