Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA) request for information on parking fines

I am writing in response to your request made on 21 August 2019 asking for information on parking fines. Please find below the responses to your questions raised.

Q. I'm after information and data regarding the street(s) in Dunedin where the highest number of parking infringement tickets are given out.

A. The top 5 Streets for Infringements Issued from 1 January – 4 September 2019 are:
