

## E-SCOOTER RENTAL SCHEME AGREEMENT FOR THE PERIOD 1 JULY 2021 – 30 JUNE 2023

## Background

- A. In 2020, the DCC adopted a Trading in Public Places Bylaw (the Bylaw) which required rental share scheme operators such as e-scooter operators to have a permit to operate within the City.
- B. An operator is required to comply with the Bylaw and Code of Practice conditions which have been approved by the DCC.
- C. In May 2021, the DCC invited requests for proposals from existing permit holders to operate e-scooters in the City.
- D. The operator's request for proposal is successful and the DCC now wishes to grant to the operator this permit to operate, as required by the Bylaw.

## Terms of the agreement

In condition of signing this agreement and being granted this permit to operate up to 500 electric scooters in Dunedin, Neuron Mobility (New Zealand) Ltd agrees that:

- a. They have read and understood the terms and conditions outlined in the Code of Practice and the Trading in Public Places Bylaw.
- b. The trading activity is in accordance with the Code of Practice and the Trading in Public Places Bylaw.
- c. The trading activity shall be limited to:
  - a. Maximum of 500 e-scooters;
  - b. Operating hours of 5am 12am.
- d. They understand that the permit to operate is issued for the period of 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2023 but that the permit may be altered, suspended or cancelled in accordance with the Trading in Public Places Bylaw.
- e. They understand and accept that the permit cannot be transferred to any other person or entity and that the permit will expire immediately on sale, transfer, liquidation, bankruptcy or closure of the applicant.
- f. They agree to indemnify the DCC against all liabilities, demands fees, claims, costs and expenses incurred or arising out of, or in connection with the operation of the applicant's escooter rental scheme in Dunedin. (The term "Operation" includes, but is not limited to, use or misuse, storage, maintenance, delivery and disposal of rental devices or any associated equipment or tools.)
- g. They understand and accept the fees associated with this permit in accordance with the Code of Practice and Trading in Public Places Bylaw. Administration fees will be reviewed on an annual basis and are exclusive of GST, these are:
  - a. Annual administration fee of \$500;
  - b. Per ride fee of \$0.13, charged monthly.
