The purpose of the Dog Neutering Programme is to promote and encourage responsible dog ownership and dog welfare by offering 100% subsidised dog neutering for those who may not otherwise have access to this service. This is in accordance with section 6 of the Dog Control Act 1996.

PROGRAMME CRITERIA

- 1. Applications will be considered from:
 - a) Lower socio economic dog owners based on the community services card system
 - b) Dog owners outside target group a) on a case by case basis.
- 2. Dogs must be registered with Dunedin City Council.
- 3. Approval will be granted at the discretion of the Dunedin City Council.
- 4. Decisions will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 5. Funding will be provided direct to a single provider.
