In accordance with section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 this application has been considered under delegated authority.

**DECISION**

This is an application by Port to Port Cruises and Wildlife Tours Limited for a **new** on-licence in respect of the vessel based at 837 Portobello Road, Portobello, and known as "MV Sootychaser". The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a ferry and wildlife cruises.

This is a new business using a vessel that is purpose built for its intended purpose. It is registered with Maritime New Zealand.

The application was duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the vessel, to any person who is present on the vessel for a cruise.

The applicant's attention is drawn to ss.56 and 57(a) of the Act obliging the holder of an on-licence to display:-

1. A sign attached to the exterior of the vessel, so as to be easily read by persons approaching the vessel, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol; AND,
2. A copy of the licence, and of the conditions of the licence, attached to the interior of the vessel so as to be easily read by persons using the vessel; AND,
3. A sign prominently displayed inside the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.

The licence will be subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not present on the vessel to dine.

- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

**During the period of any cruise but not other than:**

**Monday to Sunday                      8.00 am to 12.00 midnight**

- (c) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
- (i) A range of food choices must be readily available at all times that the vessel is on a cruise. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted. A minimum of three types of food should be available. The range or style of food will be shown on any menu submitted. Alternatively, the range of food should include such items as paninis, pizzas, lasagne, toasted or fresh sandwiches, wedges, pies, filled rolls, and/or salads.
  - (ii) A range of low alcohol and non-alcoholic drinks must be readily available at all time the vessel is on a cruise.
  - (iii) Water must be freely available at all times that the vessel is on a cruise.
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- (i) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (e) The licensee must ensure that signs are prominently displayed within the licensed vessel detailing information regarding alternative forms of transport from the premises.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed on the interior of the vessel so as to be easily read by persons present. A plan of the vessel was received by the Dunedin District Licensing Committee on 19 June 2019.

This being the case, the Council's Building Safety Officer cannot supply a certificate allowing an occupancy greater than the front entrance/exit will safely allow.

The reporting agencies, the Police, Medical Officer of Health and Licensing Inspector, sympathise with the applicant but we cannot stipulate a greater occupancy than is allowed.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act and we grant the applicant an on-licence authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises.
