You will be required to attend an interview to assess your suitability to be a manager of a licensed premise. A licensing inspector will contact you to arrange a time.

Signed and dated character reference (not from your employer or a relative). It must include:

- the person's relationship to the applicant
- · how long they've known the applicant
- · a statement of recommendation
- the referee's contact details.
