

## 75+ Parking Permit Conditions of Use

This permit can only be used by the permit holder and in the vehicle(s) recorded on the permit.

One permit is issued per person, regardless of how many vehicles you have. All vehicles the permit is to be used in must be listed on the permit.

Permits expire in line with the expiry date of your driver's licence.

The original permit must be clearly displayed on the dashboard when parking (photocopies or other reproductions are not considered valid).

Please inform Council of any change of address, change of vehicle, or if the permit is no longer required.

## Free parking locations with the permit:

The permit is only valid for Dunedin City Council paid parking areas.

This includes the off-street paid car parks:

- ✓ Filleul Street (opposite the Town Hall)
- ✓ Frederick Street (near the Dunedin Public Hospital)
- ✓ Dunedin City Public Library car park
- ✓ Railway Station
- ✓ Thomas Burns
- ✓ St Andrew Street (by the railway crossing)
- ✓ Queens Gardens

Your permit allows you to park free of charge for the time stated on the meter and/or signage, after which you must move your vehicle.

The permit does not allow you to park free of charge in any:

- Parking Building
- Sus Stop
- Authorised Resident's Parking Space
- Authorised Vehicle Parking Space
- Taxi Stand

- Leased Car Park
- Clearway
- Other Restricted Park
- Privately owned parking areas, for example, supermarket carparks
