Place your bin close to the kerb or roadside 30cm away from other bins, and 50cm away from poles, fences, letterboxes etc.

Do not overfill, the bin lid must be closed. Extra items placed on top or next to the bin will not be collected.

ALTERNATIVE COLLECTION DAY

YELLOW-LIDDED BIN

CLEAN ITEMS ONLY



RIGID PLASTIC ONLY



milk bottles / drink bottles / shampoo bottles / ice cream containers / plastic meat trays / margarine containers / cleaning product bottles

MIN SIZE: small dip container

MAX SIZE: 4L



STEEL AND ALUMINIUM TINS/CANS

food tins / drink cans



PAPER AND CARDBOARD

all paper / magazines / newspapers / junk mail / flattened clean cardboard



NO lids, caps, pumps and trigger sprays | aerosol cans | milk, juice cartons | polystyrene | aluminium foil | soft plastic | bagged items | don't squash tins or plastic containers



GREEN-LIDDED BIN



GARDEN WASTE

lawn clippings / leaves / small branches



MEAT, BONES & SEAFOOD

leftover meat / bones / fish / shellfish



FOOD SCRAPS

fruit, vegetables / bread / pastries / baked goods / loose leaf tea / coffee grounds / cheese / eggs / butter



NO paper, cardboard | ash | liquids | teabags | treated timber | compostable containers | soil | plastics | bin liners | flax, cabbage tree, palm tree leaves

BLUE BIN



GLASS BOTTLES/JARS

all unbroken and clean



NO lids and caps. Remove these and place in the rubbish
