

# APPLICATION FOR TRADE WASTE CONSENT: VACUUM TANKER AND/OR TANKERED WASTE

Application to discharge trade waste at Dunedin City Council wastewater treatment plants under the Dunedin City Council Trade Waste Bylaw 2020

Vacuum tanker and tanker operators who want to discharge trade waste at DCC's two wastewater treatment plants must apply for a trade waste consent.

#### Please note:

- The Tahuna Wastewater Treatment Plant only accepts grease trap waste.
- The **Green Island Wastewater Treatment Plant** only accepts septage, portable toilet waste, sewage and effluent from stock-truck disposal stations (STEDs).

All other types of tankered waste cannot be disposed of at the above wastewater treatment plants without approval.

- 2. Before consent is granted, you must be on DCC's approved contractors list, have a Current Offensive Trade Registration and Code Compliance Certification Hazardous waste.
- 3. A consent application fee is payable, in accordance with the DCC's Annual Plan, once the application is processed. Consent application fees can be found at www.dunedin.govt.nz/services/wastewater/tradewaste or you can contact the DCC on 03 477 4000.
- 4. It is important that you contact us immediately if your business changes, the person named on this consent is no longer the holder of this consent or your email or business (physical) address changes. The discharger, as named on this consent, is liable for any trade waste charges until the period of notice (10 working days) is completed.
- 5. Council does not allow the discharge of any tankered waste into any of its other wastewater treatment plants other than the Tahuna and Green Island Wastewater Treatment Plants.

## **Privacy statement**
