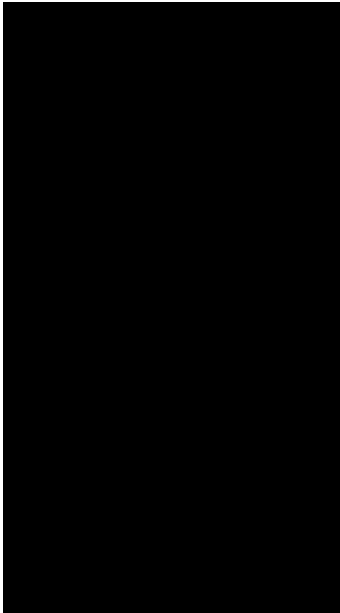

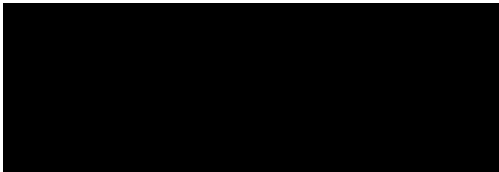

Because banning rather neutral track names based on one complaint is ridiculous. If they find these names offensive then I feel for them if they ever walked in the students' flats area and read house titles there.

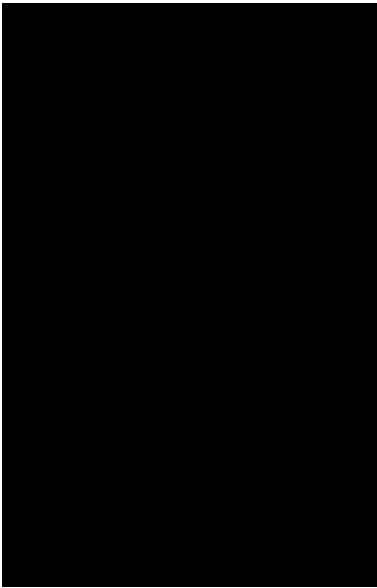

What changes would you like us to make to the Signal Hill Recreation Reserve Management Plan?

Look to enter negotiations with the adjoining quarry owners, that once the business is finished with the land, that it be jointly restored and added to the reserve to enhance the recreational opportunities of this important parcel of land. Thus creating a continuous recreation reserve through to the Stadium. In adding this land to the reserve, it would open up views of the inner harbour, utilizing the crater as an outdoor grassed venue, or unique walking / picnic space with well designed bike and walking access. Additionally, while agreeing with appendix A, more priority could be given to gorse control (as with other surrounding bush hill reserves on our skyline). There is concern about the width of Signal Hill Road (once above the urban housing area). This concern is around possible collisions between road users, motorised, cycle and foot traffic and due to this variety of road users, travelling the road at diverse times of the day an night. One option is to add a walking/ cycle track next to the road, or widen the road. There are many low visibility corners on this narrow road heading up to the Signal Hill lookout.

Additionally: Toilets in the bottom carpark behind LPHS, for walker and bikers use, and support to further enhance the access road to this carpark. (currently low grade recycled surface, which is easily potholed)

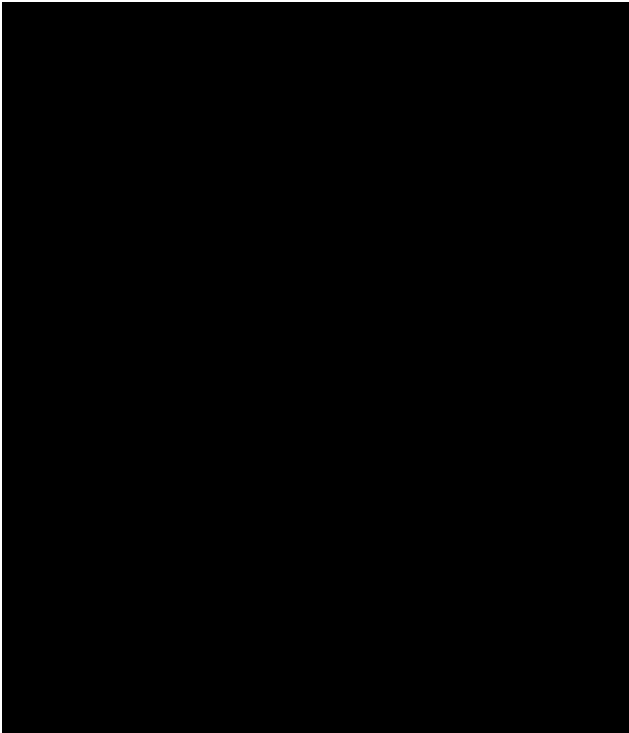

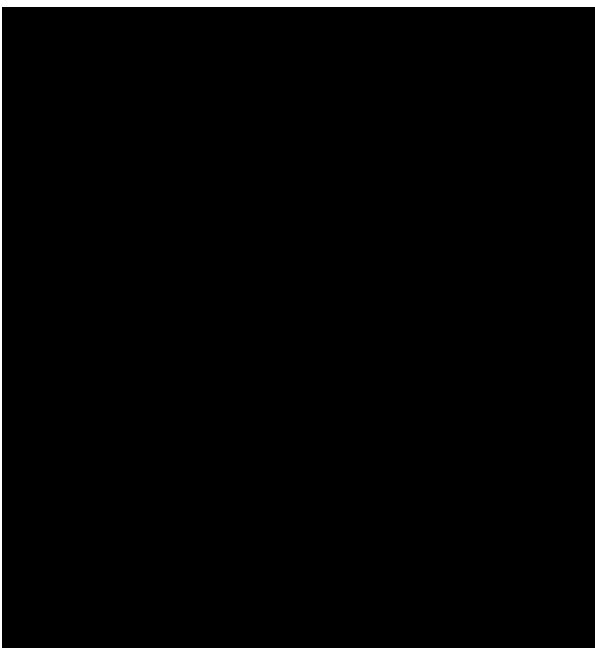

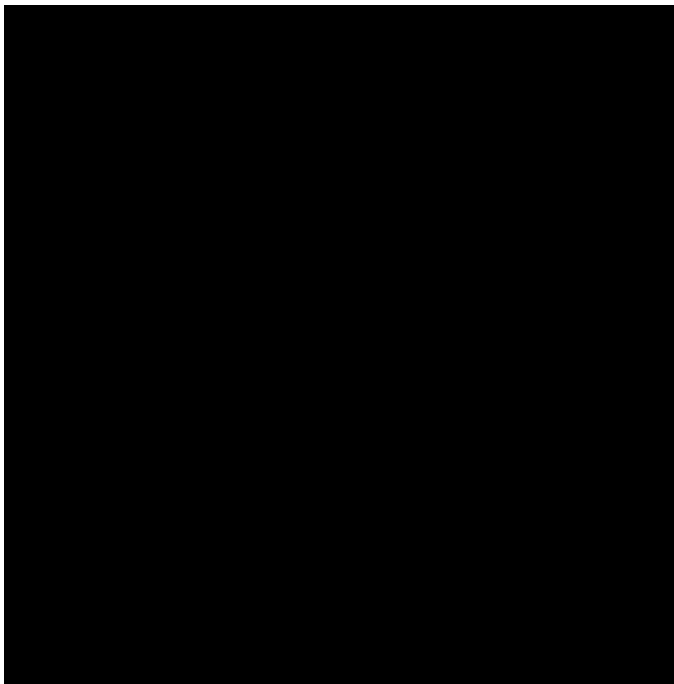

Dunedin Orienteering are very grateful to Mountain Biking Otago for the huge contribution that they have made in creating a track resource that works very well for orienteering needs. In 2017, Dunedin Orienteering made a detailed 1:4,000 map of the entire Reserve (picture attached), and it was used for the April 2018 South Island Orienteering Championships Middle Distance Event. Mountain Biking Otago were most cooperative in assisting Dunedin Orienteering to close the tracks to bikers on the day, to ensure the safety of orienteers, and in sharing their equipment resources. The map has been used more than a dozen times since that event, and is now a particularly popular orienteering area, in part due to the accessible location, and also to the excellent parking facility that Mountain Biking Otago have developed, which makes for a very good Event Centre. Recently, a permanent GPS based digital orienteering course has been established.

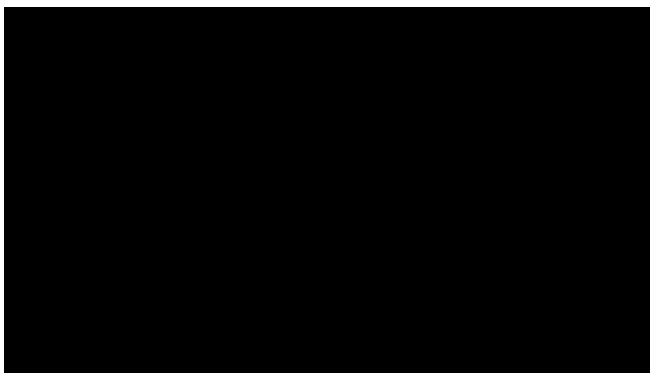

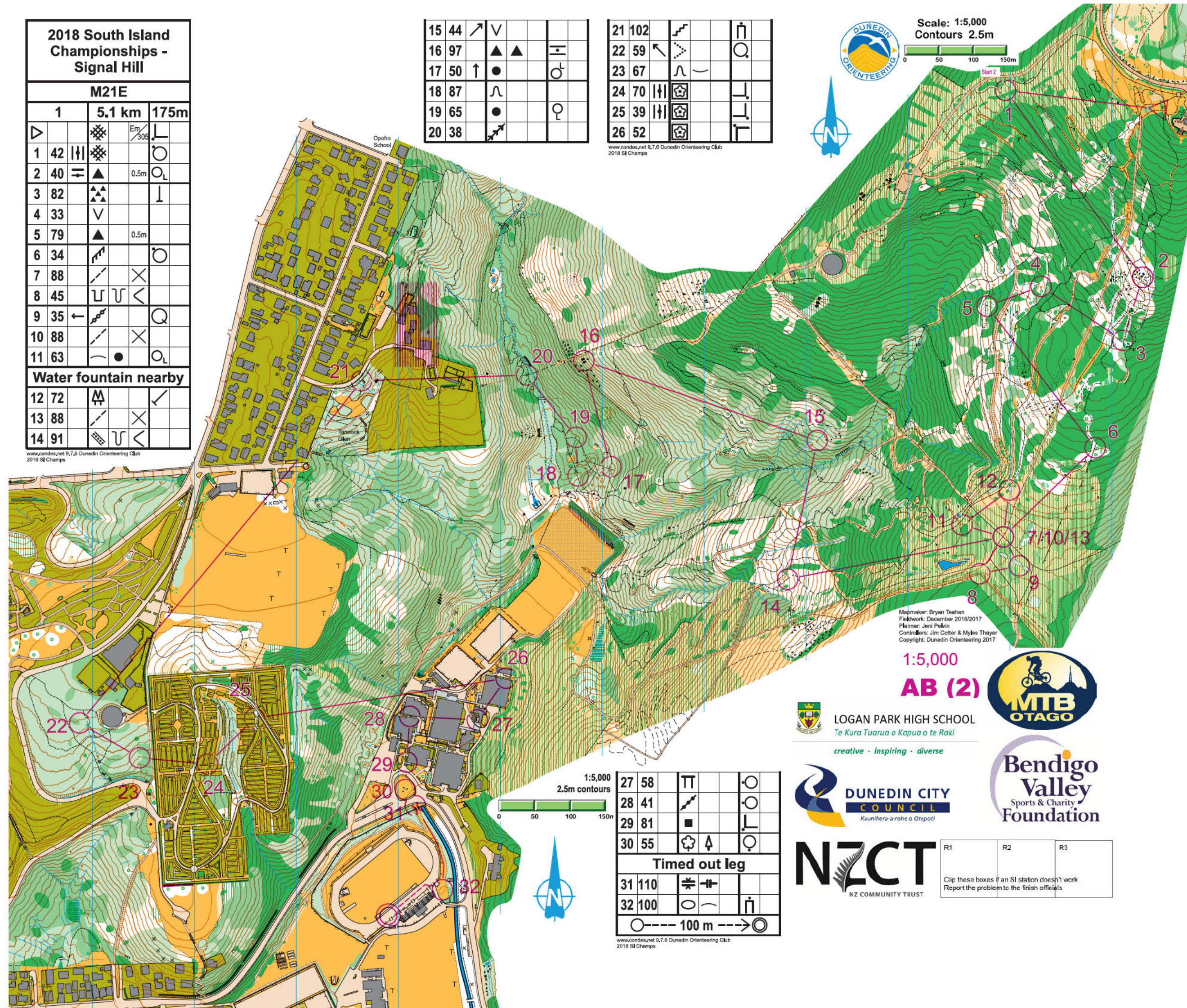

I suggest you remove all road side flax as it adds nothing but leave one or two trees that can be seen through. This is such a popular spot and there aren't many places in Dunedin with (potentially such good views).

Please consider a new footpath or road widening at the top of Signal Hill Road extending right up to the top. Toilets at the top are also needed. I would like to see the council investing more in "basic" infrastructure and improving access to some of the great assets we already have. There is a lovely area and fantastic bike tracks at the top of Signal Hill Road. Currently the road up there is quite dangerous. I have personally been in an accident with the bus I was traveling in hitting a tree to avoid oncoming traffic. The problem is even worse for pedestrians and their dogs. It's also not good for the cyclists heading up to use the tracks. Not only has there been increasing vehicle traffic up there lately the types of vehicles are some of the most dangerous we have on our roads. There are several speed bumps and recent improvements in the lookout carpark which I assume is to help address the "boy racer" issue. We can likely agree that they are not the safest of drivers to have passing you on a thin gravel shoulder as you walk your dog on a dark winter's evening. We also see tourists who are unfamiliar with thin roads like this particularly with pedestrians on them. When not driving cars and camper vans tourists also often travel in large buses which simply do not fit on the roads nor in the recently shrunk car park at the top. We see many many vans carrying bike trailers, although these people seem to be very good drivers I am concerned that they could easily clip someone with the back of a big bike a trailer. This final category of driver we often have up there during winter months are people looking to play in the snow, it goes without saying that this is not safe. Please consider a footpath and or wider road up to the top of Signal Hill Road.

What changes would you like us to make to the Signal Hill Recreation Reserve Management Plan?

I would like to see the removal of the arboretum as far as planting exotic plant species is concerned. I would like to see an increase in the wording for the removal of pest plants including but not limited to Darwins Barbury, Gorse and Pine. I would like to see enhanced MTB track development and continued support of the MTBO club where tracks are currently not present including into Land Parcel 5. I would like to see further pest control of mammalian pests including possums, rats, stoats and rabbits. I would like to see part 5.1 on current use updated to reflect the high number of MTB users that use the reserve for mountain biking and the plan to reflect the current tracks and state of tracks in the reserve. The conflicts between walkers and MTB requires updating and this should reflect the high number of walkers and runners that are using the all-weather tracks built by MTBO I would like to see a strengthening of the wording for the asset that is mountain biking on Signal Hill for domestic and international tourism if the track development was supported to a level where this could be achieved.

Please tell us why you would like these changes.

Planting exotic plants on a hill like this is a colonial practise that should stop as it adds little benefit to other native species within the reserve. The pest plants are overtaking the reserve and despite the old plan mentioning this, there has been very little that I have seen done to control anything other than gorse and after the most recent fire no effort by the council to replant the cleared area to prevent the build-up of this pest and fire risk. MTB activities are a huge untapped recreational assets that supports many businesses in town and would be worth millions a year. Signal hill is the most popular of all of Dunedin's MTB venues. Further development of tracks on the hill would only enhance what is there and fit within the plans of the recreational plans and to get Dunedin using its outdoor facilities. This includes building tracks further down towards ravenbourne and further development of the track network that already exists. The tracks have developed a huge amount and the usage of these facilities have also increased since the last plan and this requires updating to reflect the current state of use that is hugely under estimated in the old plan. Conflicts are minimal on the reserve and the Big Easy track that was built by MTBO is used by all users of the reserve and it is a fantastic multiuse track. MTB is a huge part of the city and a huge asset. It would be nice if it got the support that other smaller centres do to support track development.

Do you have any other comments about the Signal Hill Recreation Reserve Management Plan?

I would support the development of further track network on the hill as well as a sealed pumptrack, a jump line like Mc Nearly Narley in Queenstown, development of dirt jumps to bring the riding in our city up to a level that is present in other centres. I would support further planting to rid the hill of gorse and other pest plants.

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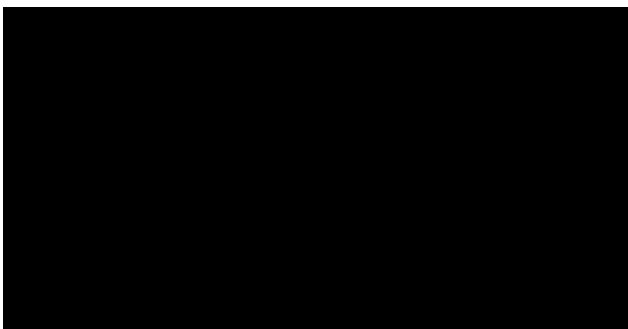

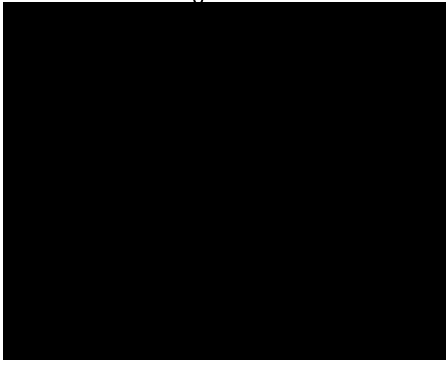
