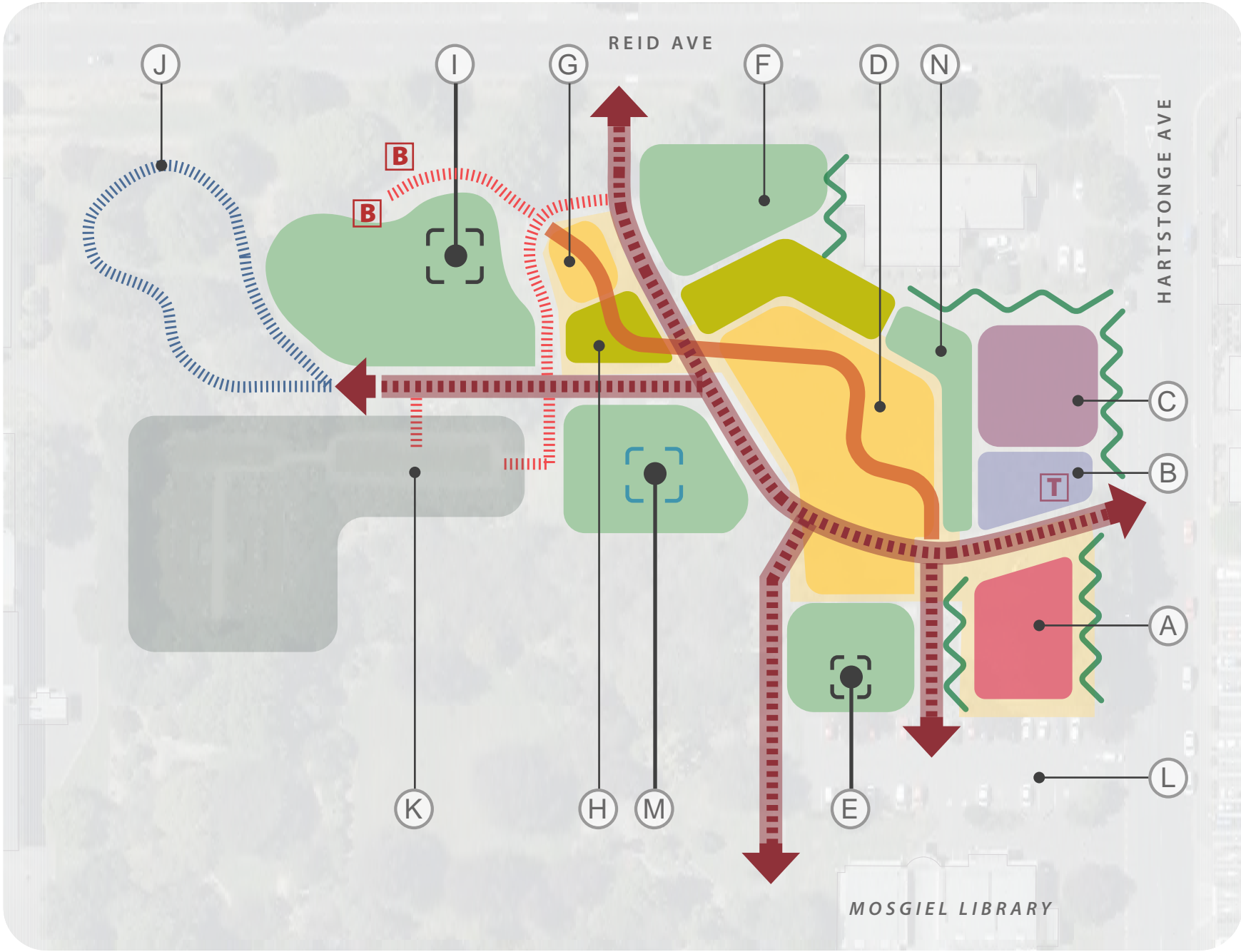
This schematic concept for Mosgiel Memorial Garden and associated character imagery serves to give an indication of development potential, the range of activities, experiences and elements.

It is noted that patterns and colours are indicative only as placemarkers for further refinement. Mātauraka Kāi Tahu will inform the design outcomes of this play space in design development creating the opportunity for mana whenua values and stories to be integrated into the overall experience for tamariki and adults alike.

The proposed approach and commentary below focusses on rationalising existing play provision, consolidating play experiences, and embracing Mosgiel's location on Taieri Plain surrounded by various mountain ranges.

- (A) Proposed toddler play area with improved setting accommodating 0-4 age range with amenity planting and fencing to carpark and road interface. Upgrade softfall surfaces to reflect park theming.
- (B) Retain existing toilet facility and upgrade entrance area as a space to meet and socialize, including supporting street furniture items to service both the skate facility and play areas
- (C) Proposed skate facility with park style skate features potentially supported by street style elements. Potential to incorporate 3x3 basketball court with creative line marking to enable dual use for creative games and play on all weather hard surface.
- (D) Appropriately themed play equipment and experiences for 5-12 (Junior) age range incorporating existing net structures, supernova, 2no. basket swings and inclusive play elements, with additional sliding, agility and creative elements (role play / musical / sensory) to compliment existing provision.
- (E) Retain existing flexible grassed open space with natural mounds with seating and amenity planting buffer to carpark interface.
- (F) Flexible grassed open space with the potential to accommodate a range of ball and recreational activities.
- (G) Retain existing social swing and upgrade safety surfacing
- (H) Proposed nature play area incorporating informal connection/ seating and balancing play elements to provide additional playful connection between the social swing and the adjacent play area
- (I) Consider relocation of play activities accommodated in this area to create a dedicated flexible grassed open space for community activities including informal events / family gatherings, socialising and BBQ areas for a wide range of user groups.
- (J) Retain existing loop path and improve play experience with additional pump bumps / wheeled play elements.
- (K) Potential to enhance entrance and connectivity to existing formal gardens with planting and formal access off proposed circulation routes.
- (L) Retain existing carpark and associated pathway connections to existing Mosgiel Library and improve experience with amenity planting
- (M) Potential water play plaza and flexible open space connection to community gardens
- (N) Flexible grassed open space transition and social spill out area between junior and youth play areas

NOTES

01. Realign and widen concrete pavement to improve setting and connectivity to the playspace and toilet facility from Hartstonge Avenue. Should renewal of toilet block be considered, there is also opportunity for reorientation of this facility
02. Proposed toddler play module with two platform with a connecting elements, a 1.2m tall double slide and sandplay attachment for sensory/role play opportunity
03. Proposed 'Cow' rockers on synthetic turf surfacing
04. Stepping logs, sculptural pods, insect hotels and talking tubes set amongst planting to encourage exploratory play
05. Double toddler bucket seat swing set on synthetic turf and rubber surfacing for accessible access
06. Post and wire fencing and hedge row to proposed toddler play area adjacent to carpark and road, providing physical barrier for safety that still allows visual connectivity between the main play area and the specific toddler area
07. Proposed min. 1.2m wide 'Taieri River' path connecting the playspace, providing an accessible experiential route with opportunity for exploratory games
08. Relocation of existing picnic set with proposed shade sail structures
09. Flexible grass open space transition between playspace and skatepark
10. Retain and protect existing mature trees
11. Retain existing double basket swing and resurface wetpour rubber surfacing
12. Retain existing inclusive carousel
13. Retain existing spinner bowl
14. Propose additional spinner bowl to match existing
15. Propose music play on wetpour rubber surface
16. Relocation of existing liberty swing with new wetpour rubber surfacing and improved setting and fencing for better integration with surrounding play elements
17. Proposed flexible grass open space
18. Timber log scramble trail in planting for informal connectivity
19. Retain existing double space nets, resurface wetpour rubber surfacing and inclusion of planting to improve setting and amenity
20. Retain existing 2no. Spica spinner
21. Post functional life, remove existing play platform to create flexible grass open space area adjacent to the existing BBQ and shelter area for spill out and kick a ball opportunity
22. Retain and refurbish existing social swing set and wetpour rubber surfacing
23. Relocation of existing super nova on wetpour rubber surfacing and improved setting
24. Proposed informal paver connection to water play plaza
25. Proposed plaza setting with inground misting jets adjacent to the formal gardens for informal water play opportunity with dual function, the plaza space can be used for social gatherings as well as a quiet space for respite. Proposed reinstatement of memorial / sponsorship pavers with opportunity for additional future patron pavers as soldier course edge to plaza surround.
26. Proposed play tower with 3m tall tube slide and 1m tall double slide, including multiple platform levels, climbing nets and provision for role play opportunities
27. Proposed flow skate park
28. Proposed street style skate area
29. Retain existing flexible grass open space and natural mound
30. Existing BBQ and social gathering space with adjacent flexible grassed open space
31. Proposed 2m wide pathway connection from proposed water play plaza to existing formal garden
32. Existing formal garden
